From Father's Desk... "WHEN YOU TOO DO THIS, REMEMBER ME!":


Today we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Our Lord. Last week we celebrated God as God, the Trinity; this week we celebrate God as one with us through the humanity of Jesus. Our readings speak of remembering and 're-membering'. We are members of the mystical body of Christ, caught up in a mystery far above us and beyond us. Necessarily, it can be spoken of only in metaphorical language. Jesus and Paul use the image of the body that lives on normal food. To eat means to welcome, to accept, to receive. Which is what we do when we 'take and eat' after the command of Jesus. What we do 'in memory' of Him, helps us to 're-member' the mystical body of which we are parts. Just as the food we eat becomes us, so we, who share in the body and the blood of Christ, become Christ. We are simultaneously many and one. Ordinary food gives ordinary lives. The spiritual food of the Eucharist gives spiritual life, which last forever. We must never forget that when Jesus invited us to partake of the body and blood, as in today's Gospel, many of his listeners misread the metaphor and walked no more with him. Jesus still asks: 'Do you also want to go away?

If we believe that tomorrow will be better,
