From Father's Desk... "GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD!" (Jn3:16).

There is an invitation that haunts us all our lives to mo

There is an invitation that haunts us all our lives, to move from two to three –from duality to trinity. We live mostly in the either–or world of duality. Today as we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity, we are challenged to expand our vision and see God in a new light. The early Fathers of the Church came up with an image that we rarely hear today. They referred to the Trinity as a **perichoresis** – a circle dance. It is a flow of love that goes round and round from person to person and each of us is called into the dynamic relationship. While duality leads to opposition and confrontation, trinity leads to relationship. We need to return to a love-relationship with the earth, with each other and God.

Our 1st Reading makes it clear that God is not 'out there' but 'right here'. Intimacy, closeness, acceptance are the strategies of God. Paul in our 2nd Reading speaks of the God of love and peace. He challenges the Corinthians to reflect in their living the same loving relationship that characterizes our Trinitarian God. The Gospel takes us back to the extraordinary Jn. 3:16 about a God who truly loved the world, and stresses the need for us to respond by opening ourselves to the offer of new life.
