From Father's Desk...

"THE WHOLE ASSEMBLY APPROVED THE PROPOSAL.":

The beautiful theme of concern for the community runs through all three readings today. It characterized the early Church and so impressed the gentiles that they remarked, 'See how these Christians love one another.' Our first reading deals with a practical concern - that of distributing provisions to orphans and widows. The Apostles felt that they should confine themselves to preaching. Deacons should be chosen to deal with the distribution.

Peter in the Second Reading broadens the canvas. All Christians in virtue of their priesthood are call to community service. To this end they have been consecrated through Baptism. We need to banish the notion that chosen-ness, priesthood, consecration belong only to Priests and Religious. All are called to praise God and to give others cause to do the same.

In the Gospel today we revisit John14 - having been there already three times in the past week. We pause to admire again the sensitivity of Jesus towards his beloved Apostles even as his death looms on the horizon. Questions from Thomas and Philip lead Jesus to flesh out his message of concern. The opening line of our Gospel today aims at restoring calm and courage while Jesus is away preparing an everlasting home for his people. Are we willing to make our personal contribution to our sisters and brothers?

If you don't design your own life plan, chances are you'll fall into someone else's plan.
