REFLECTIONS FROM FATHER'S DESK...



KNOW PEOPLE, KNOW GOD! The Khasi tribes, among whom some of my friends work, have a beautiful phrase that they use when guiding people on the path of life. They will say 'you need to know people and know God.' This double knowing is rooted in our relationships with each other and with God. It is an experiential knowing. The fruits of such a knowing will be properly ordered priorities. Our 1st Reading speaks of family relations. There is great praise for the dedicated, industrious, diligent wife who proves a blessing for her husband. One dares to hope that such exemplary behavior of wife to husband will be mutual. Our 2nd Reading speaks of the relations between people and church. Paul invites Thessalonians to be united in preparing for the coming of the Lord. It was thought in those times Jesus' Second Coming was imminent and people were encouraged to live in the brightness of its dawning. Our Gospel is about relationships with those in authority. The parable would seem to teach that we need to identify our particular gift and then go on to use it for the benefit of others people. It is neither wise nor good when God-given gifts lie idle. Those who use their gifts well will grow in skill and more gifts, such as praise or fame, will come their way.




