# Reflections from Fathers Desk...

#### "AM I MY BROTHER'S KEEPER?" (Gen4:9):

In our Bible we have questions asked by God, Jesus, Devils, and people. The very first question in our Bible is that asked by Cain when God questioned him about his brother's whereabouts: "Am I my brother's keeper?" We notice that God did not answer. Even in our eyes foolish questions do not deserve an answer. The answer to Cain's question would be a resounding Yes. We are created for community, for relationship and are at our best when think of others. 'It is not good for man (or woman) to be alone.' (Gen. 2:18) the glue that holds us together is love, often called Spirit. When our Scripture speaks of love it uses the Greek word philia, friendship; and more uniquely, agape, brother-sister love. The kind of love that our Bible glorifies often overflows in what we call fraternal correction. Because we love someone, we challenge them to grow and to live wholesome lives. That is the message of our readings today. Ezekiel is told in our 1st Reading that if he does not correct his brother, then his brother's guilt will fall on him, Ezekiel. Paul, in our 2nd Reading, tells the Romans and now to us, that all rules, regulations, laws, are summed up in the law of love. And the Gospel is our guide for guiding others.

God is Constant – No matter what winds may thrash against us – God is always right there. Strong and steady. By your side.
